### **SUMMER SCHOOL**

Once again, summer classes will be available for students in grades 6 through 12, starting on Monday, July 10 and concluding on Tuesday, August 15, 2017. Students attend summer school classes for 1, 2, or 3 periods a day starting at 7:45 AM and concluding at 1:40 PM. Classes are one hour and fifty minutes in length. Summer school classes at the Lake Placid Middle/High School will meet four days a week; Monday – Thursday. Regular attendance is a mandatory requirement to pass summer school courses. There is no cost to **currently enrolled** LPM/HS students for attending summer school. Registration will be in person at the LPMHS Guidance Office on Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, June 27<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM. All students must have a parent or guardian accompany them to register for summer school.
