LPCSD Contact Tracing Plan

Contact Tracing Protocol

- Each school will have a designated contact person/liaison with the Essex County Department of Health (DOH).
- The expectation is the infected individual will inform the DOH about individuals with whom he or she has been in close contact.
- Once a positive test has been confirmed the individual will be in a 10 day period of isolation. The time can be increased if the individual continues to exhibit symptoms.
- The individual will get a release from isolation order which can be shared with their school, indicating that they are not going to infect others.
- Individuals exposed to an infected person should quarantine for 14 days from the last day of exposure.
- School records can be used to support contact tracing. The steps the school district has taken to group/cohort students together should limit exposure to the entire school.
